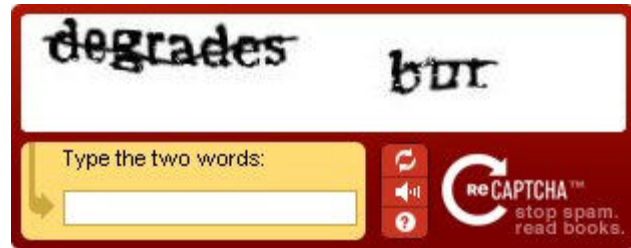



CAPTCHA by ^{RE}CAPTCHA™

Each of the web forms uses Captcha technology licensed and provided by Carnegie Mellon University. A Captcha is a program that generates and grades a test that humans can easily pass, but current malicious computer programs can not. This allows us to keep our servers clean and free from repeated and unnecessary submissions from spammers and other malicious entities.



To use the Captcha, please enter the two words in the box when you see the ^{RE}CAPTCHA™ application embedded in the form (as shown above). If you have trouble reading the “swirling” image text, click the “reload” button to request another word text. If you would prefer to “hear” the words, click on the “speaker” button (NOTE: Quicktime must be loaded on your system for this option). Finally, to view the help information, click on the “?” icon.

Instructions

- Please enter the words you see in the box, in order and separated by a space. Doing so helps prevent automated programs from abusing this service.
- If you are not sure what the words are, either enter your best guess or click the reload button next to the distorted words. If you repeatedly find these words too hard to read, please let us know.
- Visually impaired users can click the audio button to hear a set of digits that can be entered instead of the visual challenge.
